


PSD 1-1000 HAND SANITIZER/ SOAP DISPENSER MODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL OVERVIEW

In January 2021, a change was made to the soap dispenser container and backing plate. The change involved adding a rib to the underside of the hook that holds the container onto the mounting plate. A groove was added to the mounting plate for clearance. This means that any mounting plate prior to the change will either have to be replaced with a new model or modified if replacing the soap dispenser container. These instructions will guide you through the process of making the modification to the mounting plate so that it will work with the updated soap dispenser container.



Capacity: 30oz / 887ml

TOOLS REQUIRED

• Drill • 5/32" Drill Bit

INSTRUCTIONS



Drill a 5/32" hole — just below the horizontal surface in the direct center of the part.
Be sure to drill only through the mounting plate.




After drilling the hole, run the drill bit up to make the slot



Your new soap dispenser container should now fit your existing mounting plate.
